RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work as part of a team with Development & Communications staff
- Collaborate with Development & Communications staff to determine best shots to convey proper project messaging
- Retouch photos before sending to Development & Communications staff
- Capture images until you achieve desired results
- Improve image quality using various editing methods
- Use and maintain modern and traditional technical equipment (cameras, lenses etc)
- Arrange objects, scenes, lighting and background to achieve desired project outcomes
- Maintain an in depth understanding of photographic best practices and procedures
- Ensure proper lighting is achieved
- Travel to different locations depending on assignment
- Take posed and candid shots
- Take promotional pictures
- Direct participants in shots
- Remove red eye, resize, and crop pictures as needed
