

Help with Food in NYC: What You Need to Know

- **SNAP benefits will not be paid on time for November 2025.**
- If you have SNAP left on your EBT card from prior months, you can spend it in November.
 - Everyone can find food pantries/hot meals near them at www.foodbanknyc.org
- City Harvest's mobile markets provide free produce boxes at select locations in each borough (check website for dates/times): <https://www.cityharvest.org/mobile-markets/>
